Hansen himself seems to have felt the force of the objections to his method, since in a posthumous memoir published in 1875, entitled Ueber die Sto rangen der grossen Planeten, insbesondere des Jupiters, his former positive views relative to the convergence of series, and the proper angles to be used in the argu ments, are greatly modified.
